Information on Inspections and Interventions at Food Establishments

This report is based on national guidance and is not intended as a complete statement of the law. Food law aims to ensure that any food that is produced, stored or offered for sale to the public is safe. The Health and Safety at Work legislation aims to ensure that employees and the public are protected from risks to their health and safety caused by work activities.

You are legally required to register your food business at least 28 days before opening. Registration is free of charge and you can register online at www.register.food.gov.uk/new/ealing

Who will inspect your business?

Ealing Council employed Regulatory Services Officers/Environmental Health Officers have the right to enter and inspect your premises at all reasonable hours i.e. all hours of operation. They do not have to make an appointment. Inspectors will look at how you operate your business, identify potential hazards and ensure the business complies with the law. Our officers are authorised by the Council having demonstrated appropriate qualifications and competence.

Food Hygiene Rating Scheme (if applicable)

Most businesses will be issued with a Food Hygiene Rating from 0 (urgent improvement necessary) to 5 (very good). The scores are calculated as follows:

Your rating will be published on the Food Standards Agency's website approximately 5 weeks after the inspection (or 2 weeks if you obtained a rating of 5).

You may request that your rating is published before this. To do so please follow the link above.

If you disagree with the rating you have been awarded, you have 21 days from the date on which you are informed of your rating to lodge an appeal. You also have a 'right to reply' (if your hygiene standards have improved since the last inspection and you want to explain this to your customers). If you have made improvements since your last visit you can ask in writing for your rating to be reassessed (charges apply). You must provide written evidence of the improvements you have made. The relevant forms can be found by following the link stated in the first paragrapgh or can be obtained from us on request.

What can you do if you think the outcome is unfair?

If you don't agree with action taken by the inspector, you should contact the officer directly in the first instance. If the issue is not resolved to your satisfaction, you can contact the Team Leader (Food Safety). If the matter can still not be resolved you may follow the Council's formal complaints procedure
